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### Entrevue avec une Personne Célèbre

#### Instructions

For this assignment, you will be using all that you have learned about likes and dislikes or preferences for an oral presentation. It will include questions (specific and general), responses (using *parce que*), adjectives, and any new words you have learned talking about your preferences and interests.

You will be doing an oral presentation in front of the class in **groups of 2-3**. One person will be the host of a talk show and the other person (or 2 people) will be the *mystery* famous person. The class should <u>NOT</u> know who the famous person is before the presentation. The goal is to ask questions that will give responses/clues to reveal the identity of the famous person. The famous person can be a celebrity, character in a book, movie or TV show, athlete, historical figure, etc. Try to pick someone that most of the class will know.

#### Roles

- > Groups of 2
  - 1. Host introduces talk show, asks at least 3 general and/or specific questions
  - 2. Famous Person responds to questions using parce que at least twice
  - 3. **Both** create a talk show name and write a script with questions and responses that will help reveal the identity of the famous person
- Groups of 3 the two famous people must be related (partners, hero and sidekick or villain, couples, siblings, best friends, etc.)
  - 1. **Host** introduces talk show, asks **at least 3** general and/or specific questions to **both** famous people
  - 2. First famous person responds to questions using parce que at least twice
  - 3. **Second famous person** responds to the same questions as the first famous person using *parce* que at least twice
  - 4. **All** create a talk show name and write a script with questions and responses that will help reveal the identity of the famous people

## **Props and Costume**

Your group **must** create/bring props and costumes to help the class guess the identity of the famous person/people. You can bring actual props or draw them on paper.

# Good Copy

- Your group must hand in a good copy of the script (written neatly or typed) and a short report on what everyone did to participate in completing the project (Ex. Person A wrote the questions and Person B wrote the responses, etc.)
- Length of Script each person in the group must have at least 5 lines.

# Example Script

- A Bonjour et bienvenue au talk-show français! Je suis ton animateur Ellen. Je suis excitée de parler à l'invitée spéciale. Bonjour!
- **B** Salut.
- A Comment ça va?
- B Ca va bien, merci. Et toi?
- **A -** Ça va bon, merci. J'ai des questions pour toi. Quelle chanson aimes-tu chanter?
- **B** J'aime chanter la chanson "Hanging Tree" parce que c'est triste et belle.
- A Oh moi aussi, j'adore la chanson. Quel passe-temps aimes-tu?
- **B** J'adore le tir à l'arc (archery) \*\*\*shows bow and arrow prop\*\*\*
- A C'est courageux et aventureux! Aimes-tu le "Hunger Games"?
- **B -** Non, je déteste le "Hunger Games" parce que c'est dégoutant et violent.
- A Je suis d'accord.
- **B** Merci, au revoir.
- A Merci pour parler avec moi.
