

LA MAISON HANTÉE

Part A: Haunted House Halloween Scene

Using the haunted house template, add your own pictures to create a complete Halloween scene. *Include at least two monsters and 6 other objects from the handout.* Using multiples does not count (Ex. *Six bonbons*), but you can use multiples of smaller objects. Do not make it too detailed because you will need to do instructions for where you have drawn each picture in your Halloween scene. **You must fine-line and colour your Halloween scene.**

Part B: Instructions for Re-Creating Your Haunted House Halloween Scene

Write instructions *neatly* for how to draw your haunted house Halloween scene **on lined-paper** (do a rough draft first). Write it as if you were looking at the page in front of you. After completing your instructions, you will read them to a friend who will try and draw the same scene on their haunted house template. **Your partner does not need to colour their version.** Therefore, you must make sure that your instructions are clear and detailed. The goal is for your partner to draw everything exactly where you have drawn them on your page.
