Ancient Roman Dice

- Dice such as these were carried all across the Roman Empire by travelling, marching legionnaires during the 1st to 3rd centuries AD. After a long, hard day of toil and misery soldiers would come together around fires, and in taverns, drinking and playing games of chance with their dice.
- Each of these dice were hand carved from a single piece of animal bone, and made small enough to be carried in the mouth, if need be. They were discovered at a Roman military encampment near the Danube River in Eastern Europe.
